## **Round the World Cyclist to ride into Invercargill Public Library**

Round the World Cyclist, Jeremy Scott, is making a stop at the Invercargill Public Library on March 28 to hold a free presentation as part of his world tour to raise awareness for heart disease.

His unsupported bicycle ride from London to New Zealand began two and a half years ago and has seen him cover 51,916km. Having overcome heart surgery at the age of four, Jeremy now tours the world raising awareness on heart disease and inspiring people to achieve anything they set their minds to.
