Frequently Asked Questions

- 1 Is there a limit of how many entries each person can have?
A: There is no limit to how many entries each person puts forward, the more the merrier.

- 2 Can we email our finished poster through to the library?
A: We would prefer your original or a printout of your poster to the standard that you are happy with (ensuring the colours and images are as you wish it to be judged as).

- 3 Can we create our poster digitally using a computer?
A: Yes, but you will need to send in a hard copy of the poster that meets the criteria as noted in No. 2 of the Terms & Conditions, along with the digital file.

- 4 Where do I post my entry to?
A: You can drop it into the Invercargill or Bluff Library Help Desk. Or post it to;
