Conditions of Entry

1. Entrants are to submit a design that reflects the theme: bright and colourful.
2. The design must be presented to the following specifications:
 - a. Presented on white cartridge or similar quality paper (do not mount on card)
 - b. Paper size must be A3 (420mm x 297mm) OR A4 (210mm x 297mm)
 - c. No metallic colours and / or glitter may be used.
 - d. The artist's signature should be included in an appropriate place on the design.
3. It is suggested that artists aim to:
 - a. Keep the artwork simple.
 - b. Use clear well-defined shapes.
 - c. Use contrasting colours.
4. The illustration will be judged according to the manner in which the artists reflect the theme and originality. The names of the judges will remain confidential until the conclusion of the competition.
5. Entries close 7:00pm on Thursday 17 August 2017.
6. Each entry must be attached to an official entry form with all details completed clearly.
7. The entry form must be signed by the artist, who must be an Invercargill City Libraries and Archives member.
8. If chosen as a winner the entrant(s) hereby agrees to be photographed for promotional purposes.
9. All entries must have been specifically designed for this competition and must be the sole work of the artist who signs the entry statement as the artist.
10. Prizes will be awarded to individual entrants in each of the following age categories: 0-12 years, 13 -17 years, 18+ years. Age is determined on the date of entry submission.
11. There will be ONE overall winner who will receive the grand prize package.
12. The winner(s) will be announced during Library Week on Friday 18 August 2017.
13. The overall winning poster design will feature on a limited edition Library card.
14. Confirmation of the prize will also be made in writing to the winner(s).
